LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION:

All courses on Bachelor's and Master's programs are taught in English.

COURSE REGISTRATION

Students must fill out a course registration form and submit it to the Office of the Registrar by the application deadline to be enrolled at AUCA for the desired semester. Visiting/exchange students can take any courses listed in the University catalogue, given that course prerequisite conditions are met, where necessary. The maximum allowable number of course credits a visiting/exchange student may take is 30 (ECST) per semester. Minimum course load 15-18 credits per semester

GRADING SCALE:

Grade Point Average (GPA) scale ranges from F to A (from 0.0 to 4.0). The lowest passing grade is D–

VISA

All international students should start their visa application to the Kyrgyz Republic no later than 30 days prior to their arrival. AUCA provides letters of support for all students who require it. Visa procedures differ greatly depending on your country of citizenship.

Health Insurance:

All exchange students are required to arrive with health insurance. In case health insurance doesn't cover Kyrgyzstan, it can be purchased in country upon arrival.

Transportation from Airport:

The service is available. Request airport pick-up two - three weeks prior to student's arrival.
