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**Students' Selection Procedure for
Participating in the Intensive Summer
Programme for Economics Students
"Corporate valuation and financial
simulations in global financial markets"**

Erasmus+ project for Higher Education Co-Funded by the European Union

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The intensive summer programme for economics students "**Corporate valuation and financial simulations in global financial markets**" will be organized between 25th of June – 1st of July 2024 in Sibiu (arrival on the 24th of June, departure on the 2nd of July 2024), Romania and students from three partner universities will participate. The number of students accepted to take part in each event is: **Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu – 15 students, Università degli Studi di Siena - 5 students; University of Opole – 5 students.**

The process of selection will be organized respecting the principles of transparency, the equality in terms of opportunities of access and avoiding the conflict of interests (in establishing the commission for selection and in granting).

The **eligibility criteria** for participating students:

- Bachelor economics students. The present intensive summer programme is addressed to Bachelor economics students, enrolled in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of study.
- English language skills. As the activities carried out during the summer schools will be held in English there will be requirements regarding language skills in English. Bachelor students in economics who hold a language certificate attesting their level of English knowledge (minimum B1) or who have participated in a selection interview in English to test their level of English will be considered eligible.

Financial support

Each student will receive individual support in the amount of **522 EUR + 275 EUR** for travel support.

Students are requested to submit the following documents:

1. Student application form (available [here](#))
2. Motivation letter
3. CV
4. Certificate of student status (can be obtained at the Dean's Office)
5. Transcript of records (can be obtained at the Dean's Office)
6. English language certificate (if exists; if not, the student will be interviewed for testing the English language skills by selection commission)
7. Certificate confirming social aid scholarship received at the University of Opole (if applicable).

Documents specified above shall be submitted to Ms. Magdalena Rudy (mrudy@uni.opole.pl) **till 25th March 2024** at the Erasmus+ - Office for Research and Project Management of the University of Opole (KMICIC hall, 31 Grunwaldzka Street, room no. 11, ground floor).

Candidates who submitted all documents required except for English language certificate (minimum B1 level) will be interviewed by commission established **on 28th March 2024 at 9 am** at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Opole, room no. 18.

The **selection criteria** are:

- Motivation;
- English knowledge level;
- Academic performance. The academic performance is based on the general average years of study.

The ranking of eligible students and their selection will be made according to the following formula:

$$\text{Final score} = 40\% * \text{Motivation} + 30\% * \text{English knowledge level} + 30\% * \text{academic performance}$$

In order to help integrating the students facing economic obstacles, we will give prioritized access to 1 student who fall into the category "Social Aid Scholarships" **or to socioeconomically disadvantaged students' category.**

Candidates will be informed about selection results till **02st of April 2024**. The deadline until which the contestations can be submitted is **05rd of April 2024**. Any contestations submitted will be analyzed and solved by the commission established.

After the process of selection, the list of selected students and the waiting list will be posted in descending order according to the score obtained by every student.

Information about final results will be made public till **10th of April 2024**.

Other information:

- **Students participating in this intensive summer programme will receive 3 ECTS credits.**
- The selected students can opt for the accommodation in the Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu, Romania campus (if they want). The price will be 60 lei (12 euros)/night/person, in a double room. The lunch at campus cafeteria is about 5 euros/person/day.
