About the program:

General qualification criteria:

- a BA or MA degree in sociology, political science, international relations, journalism and social communication, ethnology, European studies, pedagogy, economics, family studies, social policy, social work, health promotion, management, cultural studies, philology (diplomas in other disciplines will be subject to the coordinator's verification);
- B2 level language proficiency in English (confirmed with a recognized certificate or an online oral exam).

Future career prospects:

During the program students acquire such skills as analytical and critical thinking, problem solving, project work, teamwork, English language proficiency, knowledge of the corporate culture, EU and non-EU countries, research, international experience, which can be applied while working for the multinational companies, NGOs, governmental structures, small business enterprises, international departments of educational institutions.
