Greetings from National Dong Hwa University, Taiwan.

This year, with the financial aids from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), Taiwan, we are very much pleased to offer scholarships to EU students from our partner universities who join our exchange program for Fall Semester 2021 (2021/09 – 2022/01) to discover not only NDHU but also Taiwan in general. Most importantly, because of the COVID-19, non-degree students are not allowed to enter Taiwan yet, but the MOFA Taiwan opens "special entry permit" for these scholarship recipients expecting to visit Taiwan for short-term studies.

[the EU-TW scholarship includes]

- a. a guarantee of entry permit
- b. full tuition waive
- c. a stipend of NTD 100,000 (around EUR 2,950)
- d. a transcript and a certificate

[the scholarship recipients are responsible for]

a. accommodation fee (NTD 10,000/semester)

\* on-campus dormitory is guaranteed for students.

b. quarantine fee (NTD 40,000 in total, includes meals, transportation, PCR-test, etc.).

\* according to the entry measure of the CDC Taiwan, foreign students are required to go to a quarantine hotel for a 14-day home quarantine period. After completing the home quarantine period, they shall practice self-health management for 7 days and take a PCR test before entering the university campus. NDHU will pick-up students from the airport and help arrange the following transportation, quarantine hotel, meals, PCT test, and take students back to the university. It takes about NTD 40,000 dollars in total for 21 days.

c. living cost (NTD 8,000/month)

[the scholarship recipients are requested to]

a. choose ONE mandarin course

\* it is just an introductory and basic mandarin course.

b. join "Hands Together" activities TWO times

\* the "Hands Together" activities are held for the local elementary and junior high school students, in which the foreign students will lead the local students learn more about other countries, cultures, languages, and so on. Please see the attached photos. It usually takes about a half day at one time.

c. help promote his/her home university to our students

\* every semester, we have a sharing session for our students who are interested in the outbound exchange program. We would like to invite foreign students to introduce their home university to NDHU students.
