## **Students' Selection Procedure for Participating in the Intensive programme for higher education learners for students of the Health Science (physiotherapy, midwifery, nursing)**

**Title: Training and teaching of correct prophylaxis during pregnancy and puerperium**

**(Learning, Teaching and Training Activities: C6)**

The Intensive programme for higher education learners for students of the Health Sciences "Training and teaching of correct prophylaxis during pregnancy and puerperium " will be organized between **12-16 December 2022 in Klaipėda, Lithuania** and students from three partner universities will participate. The number of students accepted to take part in the event from the University of Opole is: **5 students**.

The process of selection will be organized respecting the principles of transparency, the equality in terms of opportunities of access and avoiding the conflict of interests (in establishing the commission for selection and in granting).

### **The eligibility criteria for participating students:**

- Students who participated in the C2 and/or C4 training.
- Students of the Health Sciences (physiotherapy, midwifery, nursing). The present intensive summer programme is addressed to students enrolled at least on the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of their study programme.
- English language skills. As the activities carried out during the event will be held in English there will be requirements regarding language skills in English. Students who hold a language certificate attesting their level of English knowledge (minimum B1) or who have participated in a selection interview in English to test their level of English will be considered eligible.

### **Financial support:**

Each student will receive individual support in the amount of 290 EUR + 275 EUR for travel

**In total: 565 EUR**

**Students are requested to submit the following documents:**

1. Student application form ([available here](#))
2. Motivation letter
3. CV
4. Certificate of student status (can be obtained at the Dean's Office)
5. Transcript of records (can be obtained at the Dean's Office)
6. English language certificate (if exists; if not, the student will be interviewed for testing the English language skills by selection commission)
7. Certificate confirming social aid scholarship received at the University of Opole (if applicable)

Documents specified above shall be submitted via email to Ms. Daria Gogol (dgogol@uni.opole.pl) **till 11th November 2022** (Office for Research and Project Management).

Candidates who submitted all documents required except for English language certificate (minimum B1 level) will be interviewed by commission established on **14th November via MS Teams** platform between 13:00-14:00 o'clock.

**The selection criteria are:**

- Motivation;
- English knowledge level;
- Academic performance. The academic performance is based on the general average years of study.

The ranking of eligible students and their selection will be made according to the following formula:

$$\text{Final score} = 40\% * \text{Motivation} + 30\% * \text{English knowledge level} + 30\% * \text{academic performance}$$

In order to help integrating the students facing economic obstacles, we will give prioritized access to 1 student who fall into the category "Social Aid Scholarships".

Candidates will be informed about selection results till 16th November. The deadline until which the contestations can be submitted is 11th November. Any contestations submitted will be analyzed and solved by the commission established.

After the process of selection, the list of selected students and the waiting list will be announced in descending order according to the score obtained by every student. Information about final results will be send via email till 16th November.
