Students receiving a social scholarship and students with a disability certificate, according to the Erasmus+ Programme rules, meet the criteria included in the definition of "people with fewer opportunities". Therefore, they are entitled to a supplement to individual support in the amount of EUR 250 per month (for long-term mobilities). To apply for the supplement, it is necessary to submit to the Erasmus+ Programme Office the decision on granting a social grant or a disability certificate before signing the financial agreement for the mobility.
